



Speed of Processing Information

If you:

- have Multiple Sclerosis
- are between the ages of 18-59
- are experiencing significant problems in how quickly you can process information
- have no other neurological illness

You are invited to participate in a new study examining a computer technique designed to improve the speed at which you process information.

**** All visits will be completed at Kessler Foundation in West Orange, NJ**

****If you do not have transportation, home visits can be arranged****

**** You will be compensated \$225 for your time****

What does it require?

- 8 months of participation
 - Week 1: one 3-hour visit for pencil and paper testing and questionnaires
 - Weeks 2-6: two 1-hour sessions per week during which time you will either (1) undergo an experimental treatment designed to improve how quickly you can process information or (2) participate in computer exercises
 - Week 7: one 2-hour visit for follow-up pencil and paper testing and questionnaires
 - Months 3-7: depending on what group you are assigned to, either (1) nothing or (2) one 1-hour session per month
 - Month 8: one 2-hour visit for follow-up pencil and paper testing and questionnaires
