



Are you having trouble with reading faces? Traumatic brain injury can affect the ability to recognize emotions.

**Kessler Foundation needs your help to understand how traumatic brain injury influences emotion recognition.**

You're invited to participate in this study if you've sustained a traumatic brain injury and are between the ages of 18 and 65.

The study will take 8 weeks. The first week involves tests and surveys that look at emotional processing and quality of life, and an optional brain scan. You will then participate in a six-week training program that may improve emotional processing. In the last week, there is a follow-up test and an optional brain scan. You will be compensated for your time.
