

Are you having trouble with reading faces?
Traumatic brain injury can affect the ability to recognize emotions.

Kessler Foundation needs your help to understand how traumatic brain injury influences emotion recognition.

You may qualify for this study if you've sustained a traumatic brain injury and are between the ages of 18 and 65.

Study participation will last 8 weeks. The first week involves tests and surveys that examine emotional processing, quality of life, and thinking ability. There is also an optional brain scan and eye-tracking task for additional compensation.

You will then participate in a six-week training program that may improve emotional processing. In the last week, you will complete follow-up testing and an optional brain scan/eye-tracking task.

You will be compensated for your time.
